

Gift Aid Scheme

Our parish is the core of our catholic life and the heart of our community. It would not be possible to do what we do at St Mary's without the generosity of parishioners who give their time and skills in service to parish ministry and through their weekly offertory donations. We are so blessed that so many people are motivated by the Holy Spirit to do this.

The fantastic fundraising efforts of the Social Committee, the income generated by the work of the staff and volunteers in the Clubrooms, Donations made (often for specific items) and especially our weekly collections are all critical. However, one of the most important elements of the financial life of the parish is Gift Aid.

Gift Aid is a fantastic way for any tax payer (including pensioners who pay tax) to support the parish. Gift Aid allows charities to reclaim tax on money given to them by a UK taxpayer. It's really simple: you complete just one form which is available at the back of the church and after that 25% of whatever you give is added to your donation. It's like free money from your taxes directly to the parish.

For example, if you give £10 per week, which is £520 each year you would have paid £130 income tax on this amount. By completing a Gift Aid form you give the church authority to reclaim this amount of tax from the Inland Revenue, making the total amount you have given to the parish £650.

There are three popular misconceptions about Gift Aid:

"I'm a pensioner Gift Aid doesn't apply to me"

If you pay tax on a pension or Capital Gains Tax on investments you can Gift Aid up to the amount of tax you have paid.

"I'm a higher rate tax payer, I'm not eligible"

If you fill in the Gift Aid form, the parish can claim an extra 25p for every £1.00 and you can reclaim the difference between the basic and higher rate tax for yourself when you complete your tax return.

"My tax will go up if I claim Gift Aid"

No, Gift Aid is retrospective. It has nothing to do with future taxes, it's about tax you've already paid.

So if you have income (salary, pensions or investment income) on which you pay UK income tax, you can boost the money you give to the parish by 25% without paying any extra.

If you haven't already, please complete one of the forms at the back of the church, and return it to the sacristy or pop it into the collection basket.
